Sub: <u>Reimbursement of expenditure incurred by exporters on Statutory</u> <u>Compliances under MAI Scheme</u>

This is regarding a provision in the Market Access Initiative (MAI) Scheme of the Department of Commerce, MOC&I, GOI, wherein the expenses incurred by exporters on Statutory Compliances for certain industries/sectors required for exports are eligible for reimbursement.

The Government of India has allowed a **reimbursement of 50%** of the incurred charges to the extent of Rs. 2.00 Crores per annum per exporter, for carrying out Statutory Compliances under the MAI Scheme. The applications had to be directly filed with EPCES for processing and forwarding to the Government.

The details of the eligible expenses are hereby enclosed for your reference. This is indeed a major step taken by the Government to promote exports from India. Hence the charges incurred by the exporters with regard to statutory compliances undertaken/done in India/abroad for exporting of their products/services to foreign markets, will be covered under this provision of the scheme. For serving the exporters, EPCES is in process of implementation of the scheme and need few pieces of information from its member exporters.
